History:

Hudson Tool & Die Company was founded in 1940 in New Jersey by Charles Batka. In 1961, Hudson Tool & Die purchased 70 acres along North US Highway 1 in Ormond Beach, FL, where a second plant was built and opened in 1969. The company was purchased by JSJ Corporation of Grand Haven, Michigan in 1984. All operations were consolidated to the Ormond Beach plant in 1991 and the facilities in New Jersey were closed. In 2007, Hudson Tool & Die Company, Inc. began doing business as Hudson Technologies. In 2008, the Volusia Manufacturers Association awarded the Manufacturer of the Year award to Hudson Technologies.
