History: Hudson Tool & Die Company was founded in 1940 in New Jersey by Charles Batka, Sr. In 1961 Batka announced plans to build a second facility on 70 acres along North U.S. Highway 1 in Ormond Beach, FL, which opened in 1969. The company was purchased by JSJ Corporation in 1984. All operations were consolidated to the Ormond Beach plant in 1991 and the facilities in New Jersey were closed. In 2007 Hudson Tool & Die Company, Inc. began doing business as Hudson Technologies, the same year it became a green manufacturer when it fully converted to an environmentally-sound manufacturing process. The Volusia Manufacturers Association awarded the 2008 Manufacturer of the Year award to Hudson Technologies and in 2009 presented it with two Best Practice awards. Hudson Technologies earned its third international certification – ISO 14001:2004 – for its environmental management system in 2011.
